Course description	Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to successfully prepare a scientific presentation for a specific audience, and to deliver it to the public by using their voice, their body and the space around them in the most efficient way as possible.
	Topics covered will include: • How to prepare a presentation by taking into account the scientific context and the public; • Structuring the presentation: the importance of the beginning and the end; • Scientific journals and conferences; • Theatrical techniques to use the space; • Theatrical techniques to use the body; • Theatrical techniques to use the voice.
Course organization	The course will be delivered using a range of teaching and learning methods, including lectures, group discussions and activities, as well as acting exercises to control the body, the voice, and the surrounding spaces.
