Course description	<p>Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to successfully prepare a scientific presentation for a specific audience, and to deliver it to the public by using their voice, their body and the space around them in the most efficient way as possible.</p> <p>Topics covered will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How to prepare a presentation by taking into account the scientific context and the public;</li> <li>• Structuring the presentation: the importance of the beginning and the end;</li> <li>• Scientific journals and conferences;</li> <li>• Theatrical techniques to use the space;</li> <li>• Theatrical techniques to use the body;</li> <li>• Theatrical techniques to use the voice.</li> </ul>
Course organization	<p>The course will be delivered using a range of teaching and learning methods, including lectures, group discussions and activities, as well as acting exercises to control the body, the voice, and the surrounding spaces.</p> <p><b>Exam:</b> Students will be required to 1) prepare a presentation to be delivered to other students, and 2) participate to short theatrical performance to test the techniques they have learnt during lessons.</p>
